

Rural Municipality of Wawken No. 93

Policy No. 400-6 Gravel Sales Policy

Effective August 14, 2025

1. PURPOSE

- 1.1. To provide ratepayers of the Municipality access to crushed gravel.

2. POLICY

- 2.1. Crushed gravel is available to ratepayers of the Municipality to a maximum of 50 yards per tax title. Having multiple names on a single title does not grant additional yards of gravel.
- 2.2. Gravel is available to ratepayers only when the Municipality has a gravel hauling contractor hired to do gravelling for the Municipality – gravel is not available at any other time of the year.
- 2.3. No person is allowed to take crushed gravel from the Municipality's stockpiles.
- 2.4. The cost of loading and hauling is forwarded to on to the ratepayer based on the tendered rates provided by the gravel hauling contractor.
- 2.5. Gravel will only be delivered within the Municipality.
- 2.6. Ratepayers wanting gravel for their private use are to call the Municipal Office to order. A detailed list of land locations and instructions are then given to the gravel hauling contractor for delivery.
- 2.7. Larger amounts of gravel will be sold to the Village of Kennedy and the Town of Wawota upon Council approval.
