The Council of the Rural Municipality of Wawken No. 93 in the Province of Saskatchewan, enacts as follows:

1. The Rural Municipality of Wawken No. 93 is hereby authorized to enter into an agreement to adopt an emergency plan, attached hereto and forming part of this bylaw, and identified as Exhibit "A" with the following municipalities:

The Town of Wawota
The Village of Kennedy
The Village of Kenosee Lake

for the purposes stated within the agreement.

2. The Reeve and Administrator of the Rural Municipality of Wawken No. 93 are hereby authorized to sign and execute the Emergency Plan, the terms of which are set out in Exhibit "A" as attached hereto and forming part of this bylaw.
3. This Bylaw shall come into force and take effect on the date of third and final reading thereof.

Introduction

This Emergency Plan authorizes the taking of extra-ordinary action by Police, Fire and/or other Emergency Response Personnel for the safety and well-being of the community where time is of critical importance.

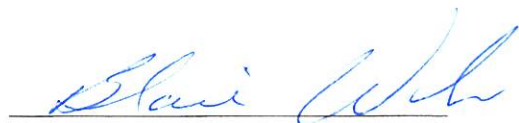

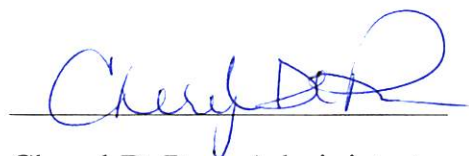

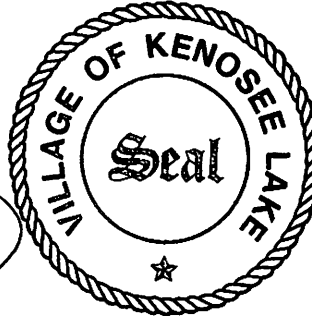

Emergency Plan

1.0 PURPOSE

1.0.1 The purpose of this Emergency Plan is to provide for a prompt and co-ordinated response to emergencies affecting the Town of Wawota, RM of Walpole, RM of Wawken, Village of Kennedy, and Village of Kenosee Lake.

1.1 *Exception*

1.1.1 This Emergency Plan does not apply to those day-to-day situations which can be handled by the responsible municipal service(s) on its (their) own.

2.0 AUTHORITY

2.0.1 This Emergency Plan is authorized in accordance with:

By-Law No. 14/2017 of the Town of Wawota, dated the 21 day of June, 2017,
and

By-Law No. 08/2017 of the RM of Walpole, dated the 14 day of June, 2017,
and

By-Law No. 09/2017 of the RM of Wawken, dated the 8 day of June, 2017,
and

By-Law No. 17-01 of the Village of Kennedy, dated the 13 day of September,
2017, and

By-Law No 2023-7 of the Village of Kenosee Lake, dated the 27 day
of June, 2023.

3.0 DEFINITIONS

| 3.0.1 | Emergency | A present or foreseeable event which requires prompt co-ordination of action, or the special regulation or control of persons or property, to protect the safety and welfare of people, and to prevent and/or limit damage to property. |
| 3.0.2 | Emergency Co-ordinator | That person appointed by joint resolution as the Emergency Co-ordinator for the Town of Wawota, RM of Walpole, RM of Wawken, Village of Kennedy, and Village of Kenosee Lake. |
| 3.0.3 | Municipal Service | Means Fire, Police, Ambulance/Hospital, Public Works and other agencies operating within the jurisdiction of the Town of Wawota, RM of Walpole, RM of Wawken, Village of Kennedy, and Village of Kenosee Lake |
| 3.0.4 | Resource | Means personnel, equipment and operational supplies available for use during a period of emergency. |

4.0 IMPLEMENTATION

4.0.1 This Emergency Plan will be implemented in part or in whole, when an emergency has occurred or threatens to occur. Implementation will be authorized by:

- a) the Mayor and/or Reeve
- b) in the absence of the Mayor and/or Reeve, the Council(s),
- c) in the absence of the Mayor and/or Reeve and Council(s), the Emergency Co-ordinator,
- d) or by Emergency Response Personnel authorized to act in accordance with this Emergency Plan.

4.0.2 The taking of extra-ordinary action by Emergency Response Personnel constitutes implementation of this Emergency Plan.

4.1 TRIGGERS

The hazards or events that could call for the implementation of the Emergency Plan. Some Examples and consequences could be but not limited to:

- a) Hazardous Materials/ Explosion
 - road closure, evacuating immediate area, proper authorities alerted
 - injury or death, and/or contamination of water.
- b) Severe Storms
 - power outage, injury or death, evacuation, localized damage and/or loss of infrastructure
- c) Black Out-Power Outage
 - summer: possible injury or death, localized damage
 - winter: possible injury and death, loss of infrastructure, localized damage and/or damage
- d) Forest Fire
 - evacuate residents in affected area, water bombers
- d) Downed Power Lines
 - road closure, evacuations
- e) Aircraft Crash
 - injury or death, power outage, evacuation

5.0 ORGANIZATION AND CONTROL

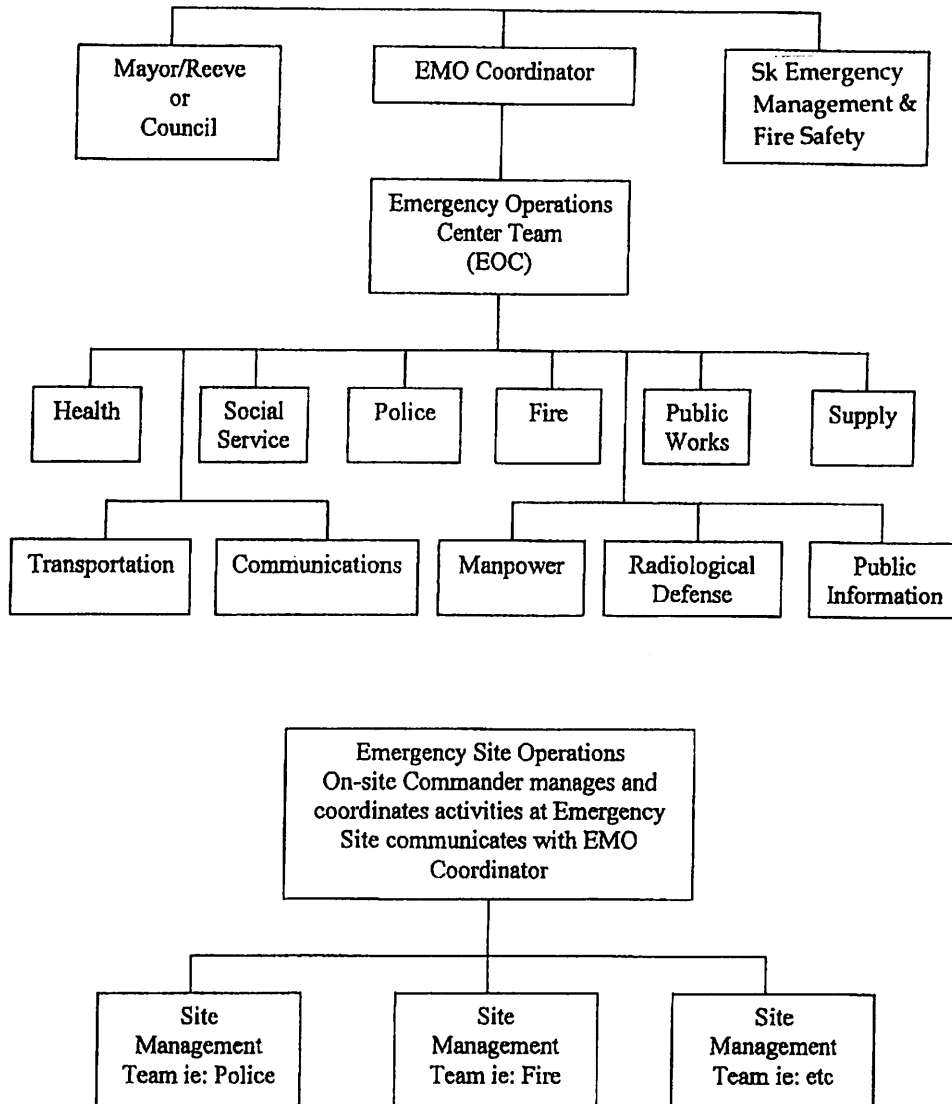
The structure, see Figure 1, and responsibilities of command are as follows:

Organization	Responsibilities
5.0.1 Emergency Control Group	
a) Mayor and/or Reeve	Direct and control the emergency operations at all times. (The presence of Federal and/or Provincial Emergency Response Groups does not alter the Mayor and/or Reeve's responsibility to direct and control the Emergency Operations within his/her (their) jurisdiction.)
b) Council(s)	1) Assume responsibility in the absence of the Mayor and/or Reeve. 2) Participation with the mayor and/or Reeve in the decision making process. 3) Assist in the execution of operational control.
c) Emergency Co-ordinator	1) Ensure reliable communications are established between the operations On-Site Commander and the Emergency Control Group. 2) Keep the Mayor and/or Reeve and Council(s) informed of developments as they occur. 3) Ensure all directions from the mayor and/or Reeve and Council(s) are carried out. 4) Direct Emergency Control Group Staff activities. 5) Ensure annual updating of the Emergency Plan.
5.0.2 Emergency Control Group Staff	
a) Secretary-Treasurer	1) Advise Mayor and/or Reeve and Council(s) on legislation and procedures. 2) Take direction from the Emergency Co-ordinator. 3) Maintain financial and other records pertaining to the emergency.
b) Clerks and Other Staff	Perform all duties as may be assigned by the Secretary-Treasurer.
5.0.3 On-Site Operations Group	
In general, the On-Site Commander will be the Most Qualified Person, unless the local authority and/or circumstances dictate otherwise.	
a) On-Site commander	1) Direct the Emergency Operations at the emergency site. 2) Keep the Emergency Control Group informed of all operations and requirements at the site.

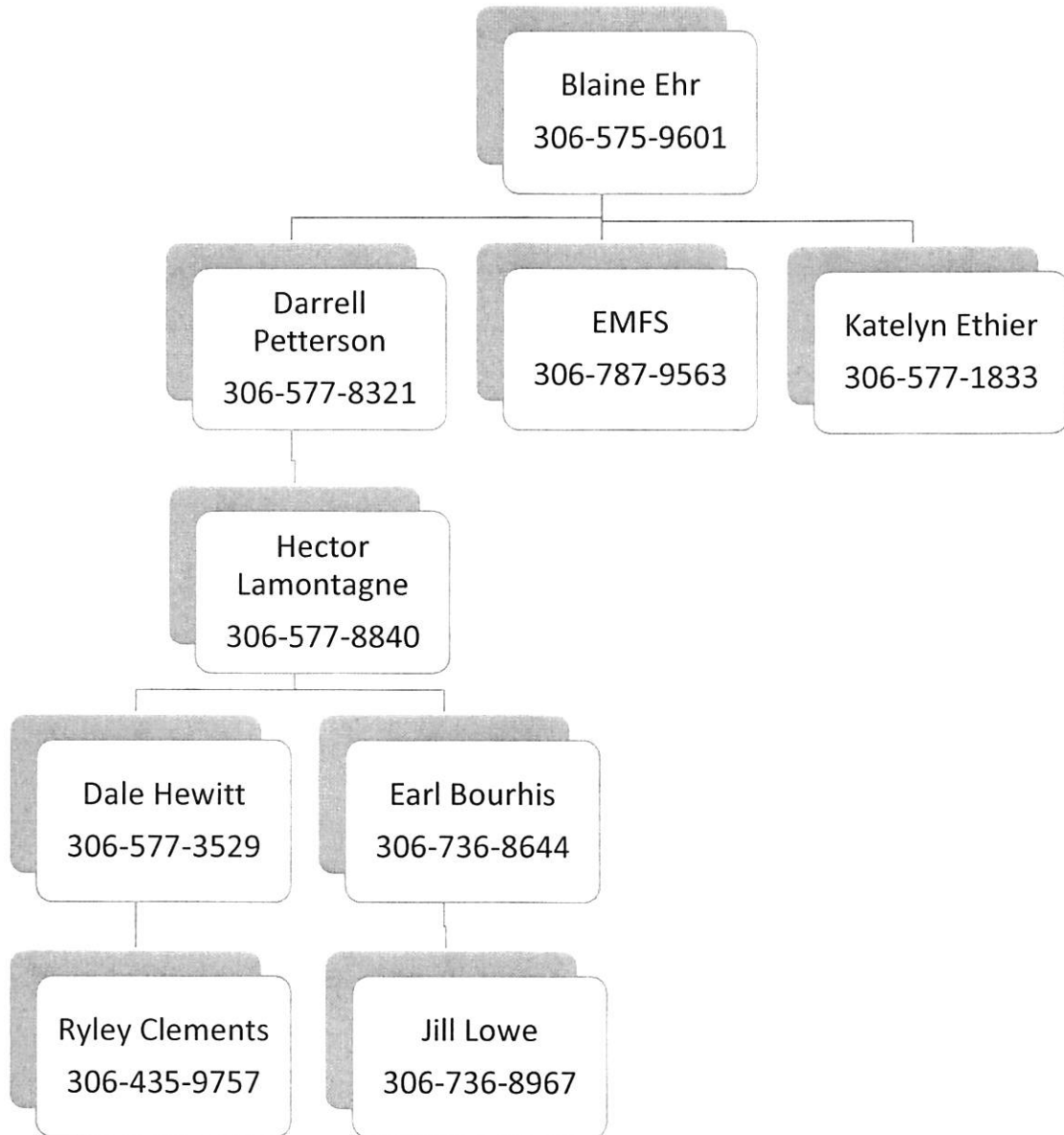

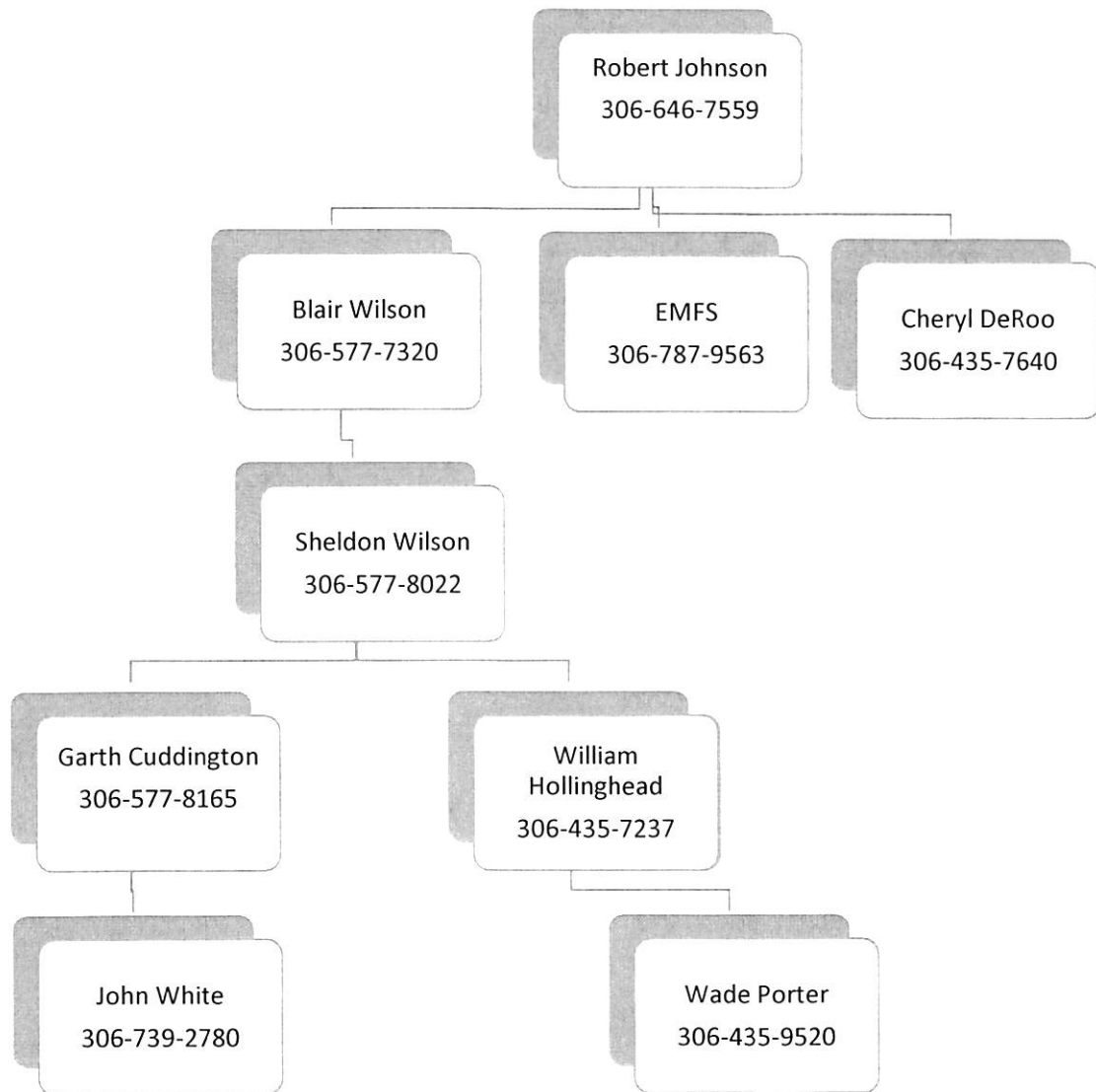

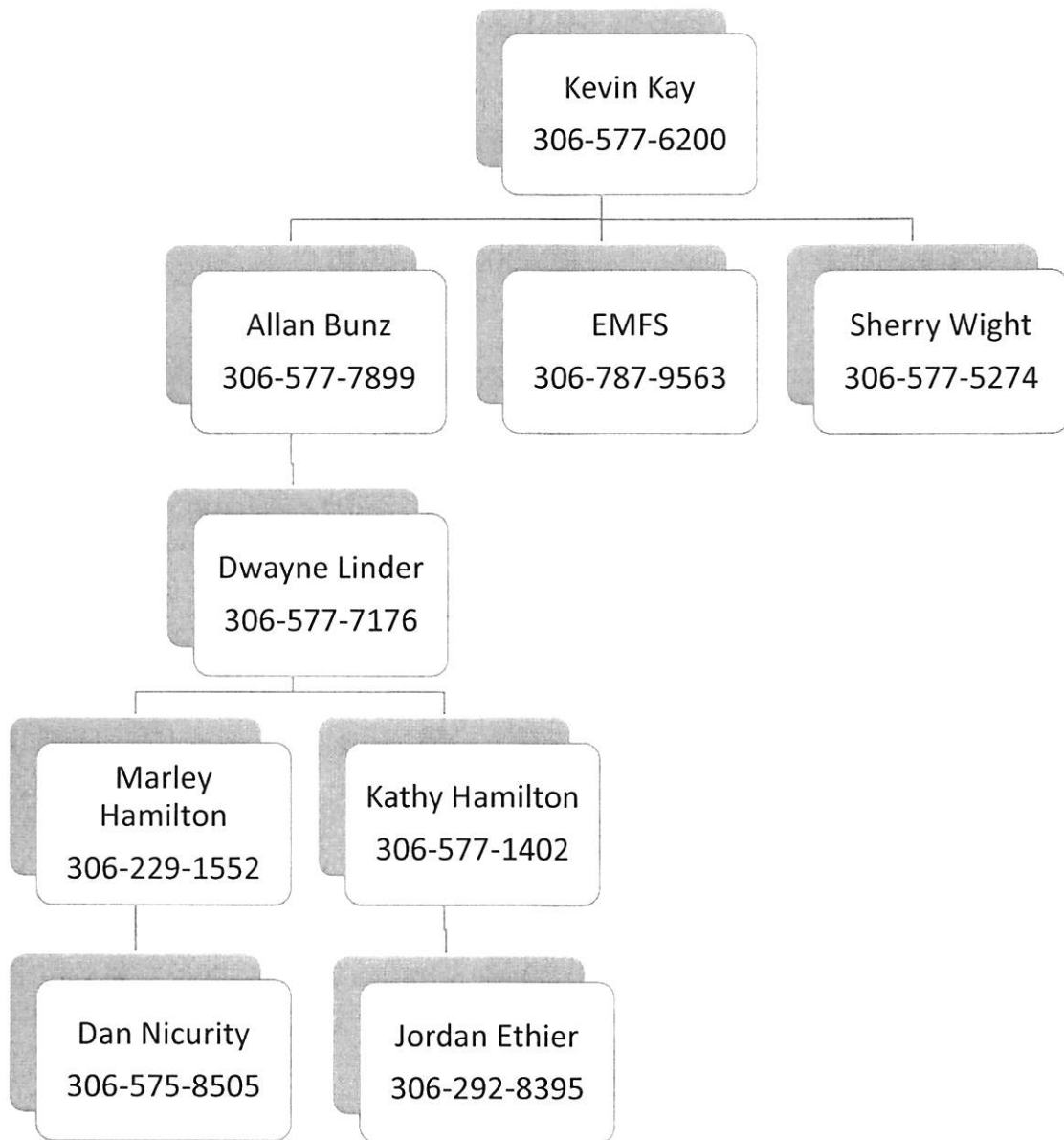
Wawken Phone Fan



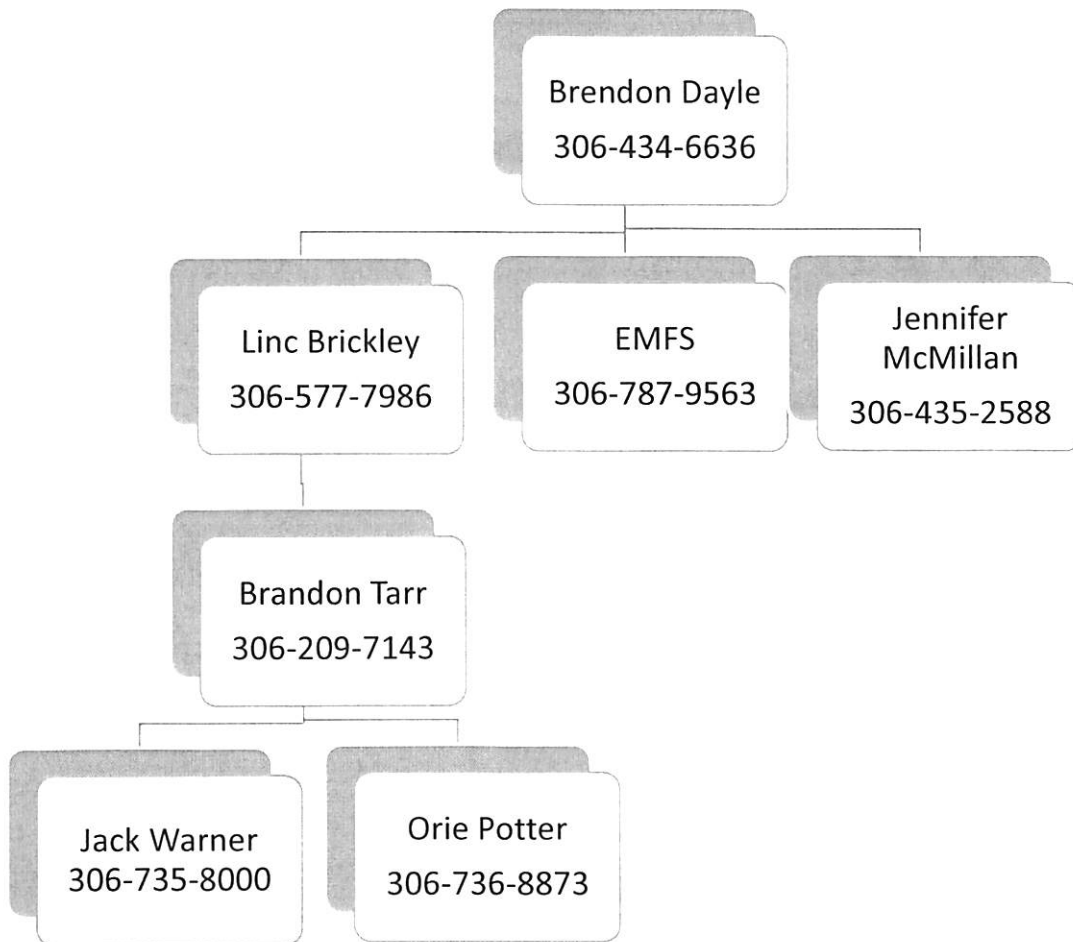
Walpole Phone Fan

EVACUATION, RE-ENTRY And RECOVERY PLAN

EVACUATION PROCEDURES

GENERAL

In the event it is necessary to evacuate people, Warning, Transportation and Security procedures must be observed.

WARNING

In addition to the General Warning (Section 1), the Emergency Control Group will ensure that:

- (a) Precise information is disseminated to the general public, as to the danger involved and actions to be taken. Notification will be through Media and/or Door to Door.
- (b) Hospitals, Schools, Personal Care homes and Group Residences in the affected area are notified.
- (c) Reception communities are notified.

TRANSPORTATION

It is anticipated that the majority of people will provide for their own transportation. The Emergency Control Group will make arrangements to evacuate persons without transportation (eg. Occupants of hospitals, Schools, Personal Care homes and Group Residences).

SECURITY

During the emergency period requiring evacuation, the Police will secure the area. Any person refusing to leave will get a second notification from other community members, neighbours and or family, then lastly the police will be notified.

RE-ENTRY PROCEDURES

Re-entry will be initiated as quickly as possible but not before local and provincial authorities are satisfied all appropriate preparations have been made (eg. The restoration of utilities and essential services to homes and commercial establishments).

RECOVERY PLAN

The Emergency Control Group will determine if there is a need for a Recovery Committee. The committee's role is to return the municipality/village and its residents to its pre-emergency state. The committee will contact other means of assistance needed depending on the emergency (e.g. counselling, public information, debris clean-up)

RECEPTION PROCEDURES

RECEPTION CENTRE

Events in the neighbouring communities may necessitate the reception of evacuees by the Municipality, Town and/or Village.

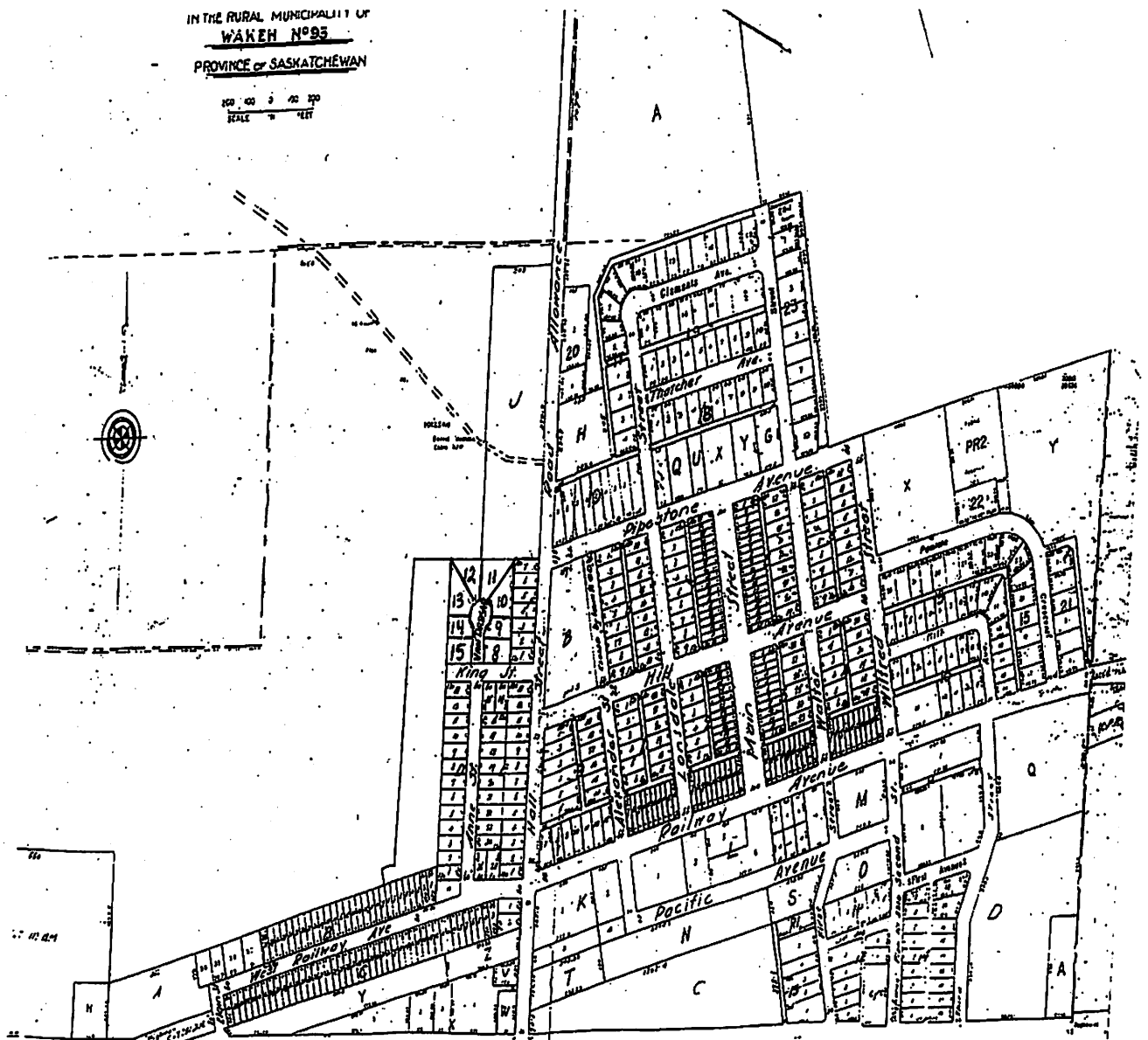
A Reception Centre will be established to register and receive evacuees and assign them to emergency accommodations. The administrator of the Municipality, Town and /or Village will open the reception centre and the EOC group will manage the Reception Centre. All evacuees are to register at the Reception centres even if they are going to stay with friends or relatives so that the Local Authority can account for them and contact them as required. Please see sample 5 Emergency Operations Centre Registration Sheet. The Reception Centre will not be pet friendly. Alternative arrangements will be made for pets.

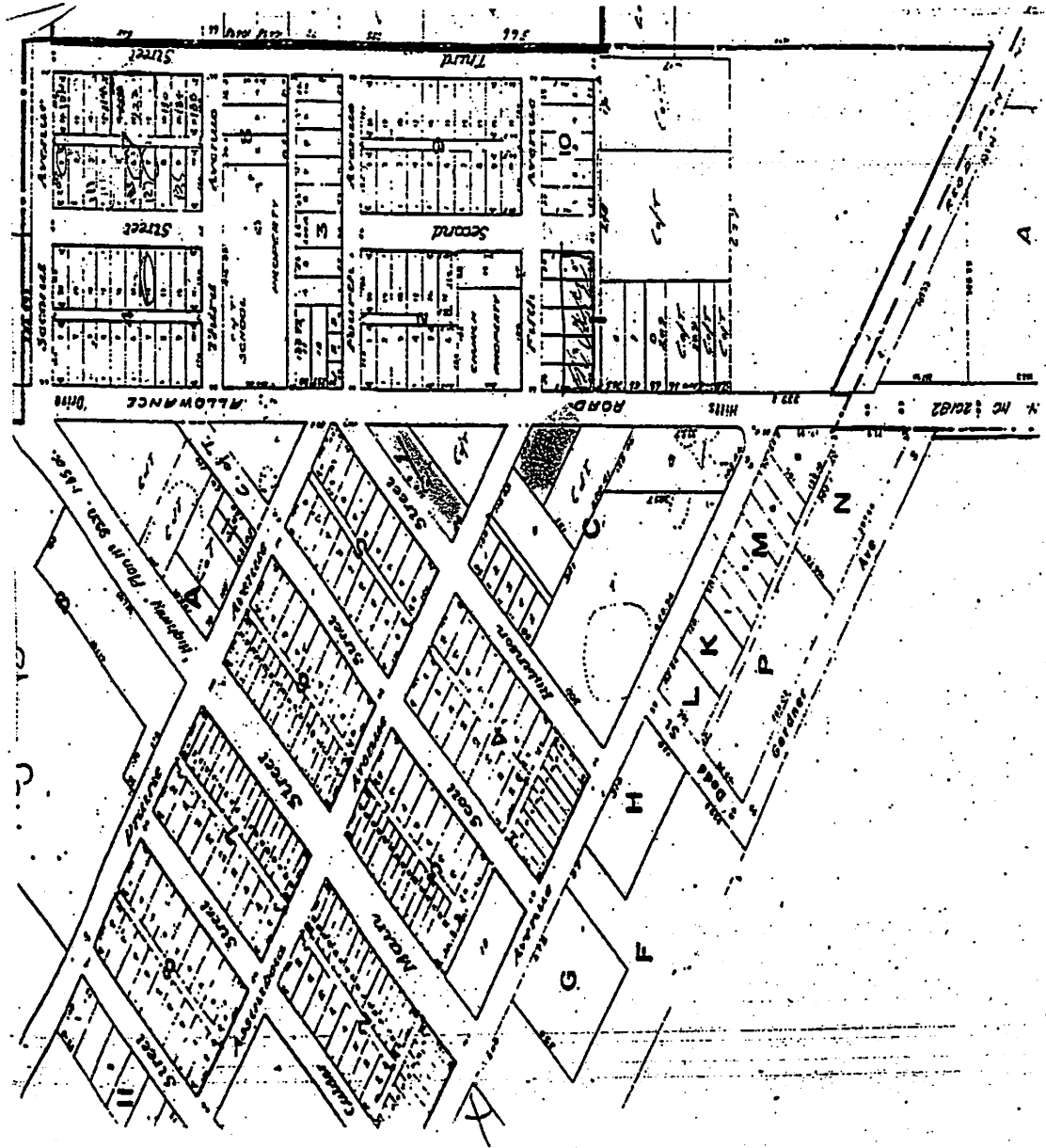

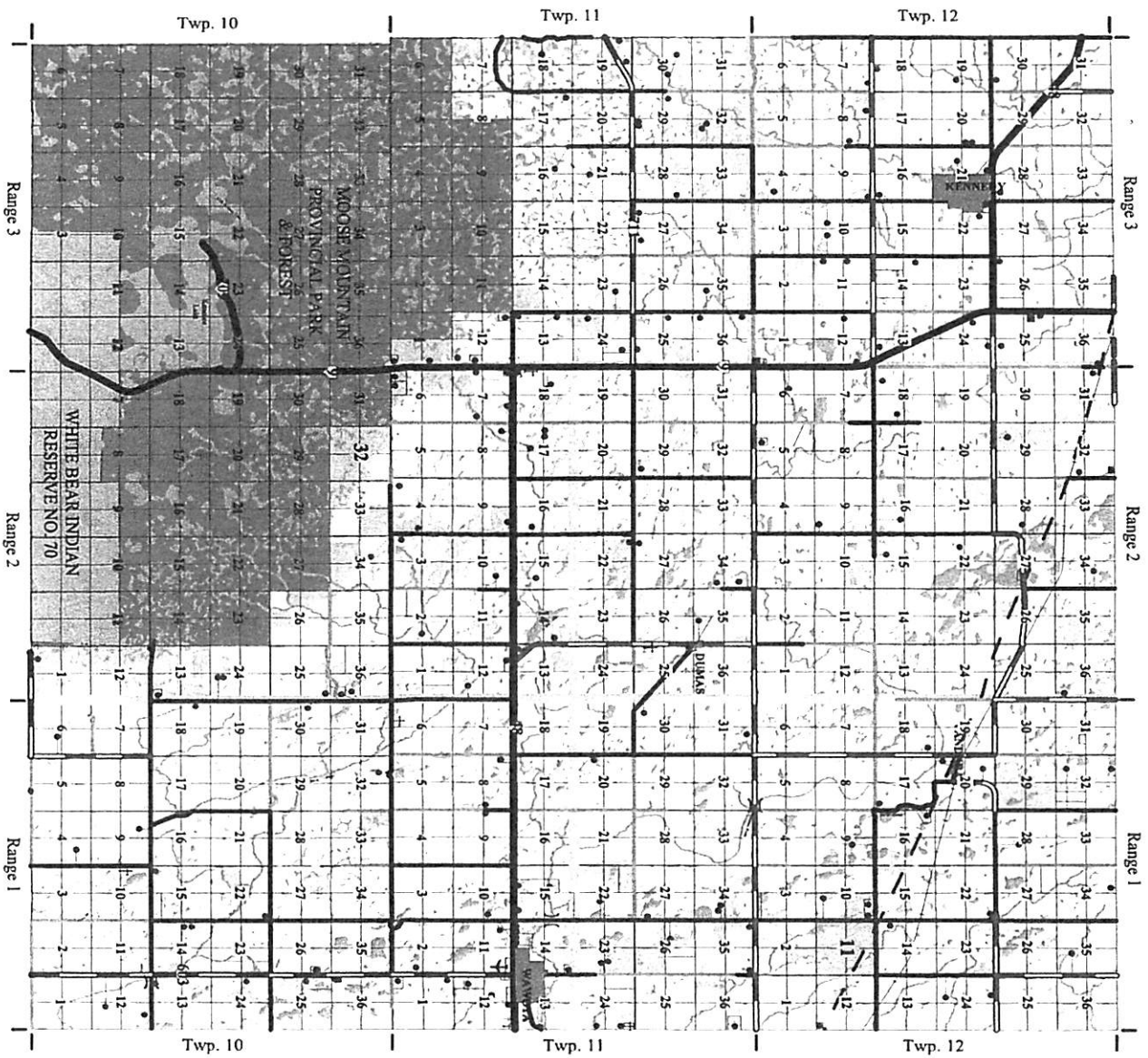
Map of the Town of Wawota



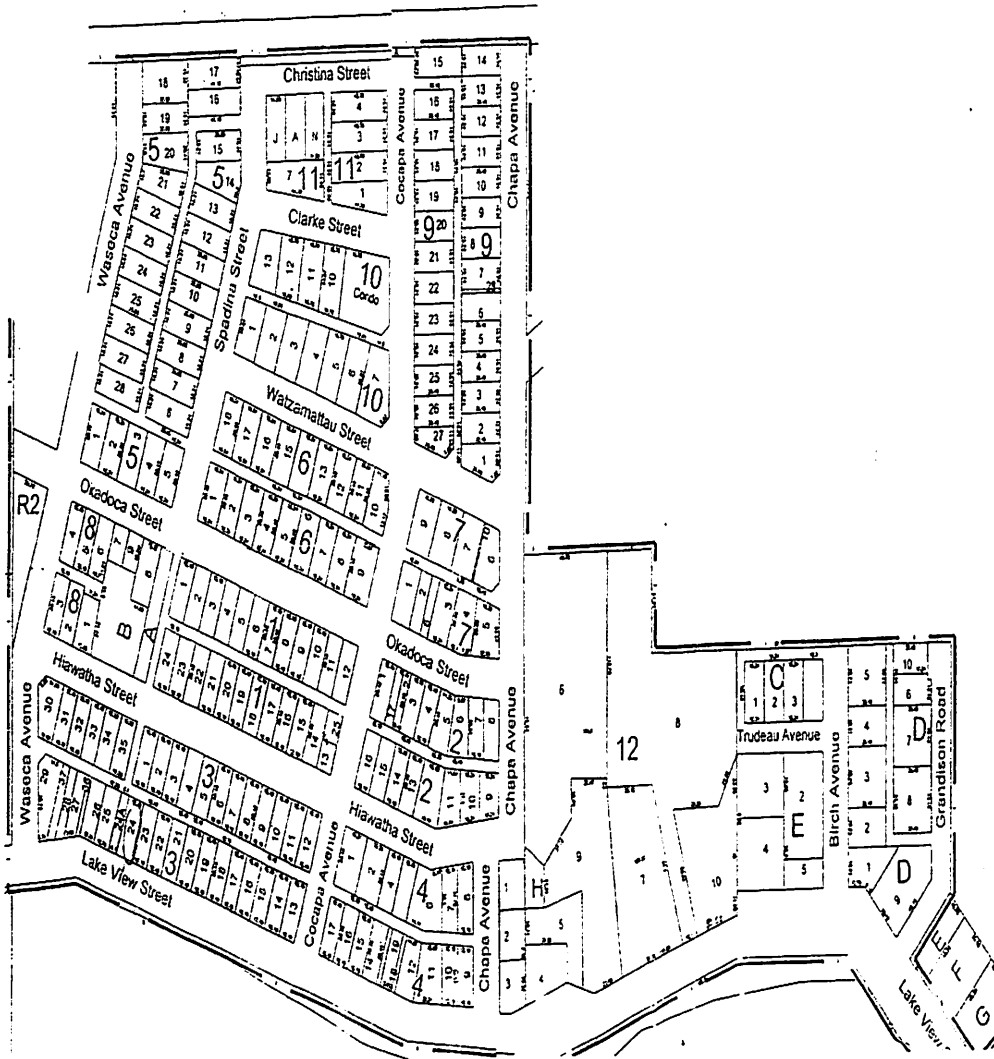
Map of the Village of Kennedy
